RaceTrac provides varying shifts to accommodate diverse schedules. Full-time workers typically put in 35-40 hours per week, while part-time staff can expect around 15-28 hours. Shifts last between four and five hours. To advance to full-time status, employees must show up on time daily for a part-time job. The company's flexible scheduling policy allows employees to choose from different shifts. However, some stores may offer additional hours or flexibility. ----- At RaceTrac, entry-level store associates can expect to earn between \$9 to \$10 per hour, with a possible raise of \$2 an hour after six months of hard work. Full-time associates typically work 35-40 hours a week, while part-timers usually receive 15-28 hours a week. Shift lengths range from 4-5 hours. The average hourly wage for store associates is \$10.60, resulting in a weekly salary of \$424 and an annual salary of \$22,048. Overtime opportunities are available due to high employee turnover, with workers potentially earning \$2,000-\$5,000 extra per year. Co-managers can earn between \$13.50-\$22.50 per hour, averaging \$18.05 per hour. The average general manager earns approximately \$58,700 a year, plus a potential bonus of \$10,000. The maintenance department offers varying salaries, including facilities technicians (\$13-\$15.50) and service technicians (\$18-\$22). Corporate jobs are available, with negotiable salaries based on work history, experience, background, and education. Some RaceTrac store associates have expressed discontent over the lack of regular pay raises, claiming they've worked for a year or two without a raise despite their efforts. It's been suggested that a promotion is often necessary to receive a salary increase. While some may have legitimate grievances, others might not be demonstrating enough worthiness for a raise. Despite offering competitive wages in its industry, RaceTrac lags behind major retailers like Target and Walmart when it comes to pay raises. For those seeking a job at this company, it's essential to understand that securing a raise can be challenging if you remain in the same position. Effective communication with management is key; express your worth as a dependable employee who has delivered quality performance, and you may find yourself more likely to receive a pay hike. However, working in a convenience store comes with its drawbacks, such as limited breaks due to busy and understaffed shifts. Staying connected with your local management team can help secure occasional paid breaks, like the 15-minute break some employees have reported receiving. New hires should note that RaceTrac provides a blue polo shirt and name tag but requires associates to purchase their own black or khaki pants. Personal style is allowed within reason: comfortable shoes are permitted, tattoos and piercings are generally accepted as long as they don't offend customers.
