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How much is the glider bus belfast

The £90m Belfast Rapid Transit Glider service has started its operations with 30 vehicles available for public use. The buses will run every seven to eight minutes, connecting key locations such as east Belfast, west Belfast, the Titanic Quarter, and the city centre. The new service is expected to replace most Metro 4 and 10 services, with bus lanes built for this purpose operating from 7am to 7pm on weekdays, the new £90m glider service has been launched in belfast, offering a safer environment for pedestrians behind funeral corteges. vehicles with blue badges will be allowed to stop in the lanes for up to 10 minutes to drop off or pick up blue badge holders. the service aims to encourage people to use public transport and improve the city's image. david sterling, head of the northern ireland civil service, described it as "all about customers and connectivity". he said it offers a quick, modern, and efficient way to access the city and its routes will link and regenerate communities. glider is often described as a "tram on wheels" and is currently operating from east to west belfast and to the titanic quarter through the city centre. however, plans are in place to extend the routes to the north and south of the city too. there are two main routes: glider g1 and glider g2. glider g1 runs between east and west belfast while glider g2 connects the city centre to the titanic quarter. for those looking to travel across belfast, using the glider service can be one of the easiest and cheapest ways to do so. Tickets can be bought on the bus for metro and Ulsterbus services, but must be purchased before boarding if you're using the Glider. There are ticket machines at each halt, or you can buy tickets in advance on the mLink app. Smartcards also work on the Glider. The mLink app gives cheaper prices than paying cash. A full day adult ticket is £3.70 while children's tickets are £1.85 and valid across both metro and Glider for a day. Single tickets on the app cost £2.20 or £1.10 for kids. Glider services in Belfast offer an efficient way to travel through the city centre and beyond. Currently, routes run from East to West Belfast but plans are underway to extend them north and south. Each Glider service features an eco-hybrid fleet, reducing journey times by 25% compared to public transport. With arrivals every 7-8 minutes, this service is convenient for commuters. You get a discount on this. Using Metro bus services now means you can pay with contactless, with £2.20 for your first journey and £1.50 for the second one, and then everything is free after that.
