Mavuika, the Pyro Archon from Genshin Impact, is set to become playable in version 5.3, releasing on January 1, 2025. As revealed in the 5.3 Livestream, her kit showcases her riding a motorcycle and applying Pyro damage with her Skill. She doesn't require Energy for her Elemental Burst. Mavuika's marketing campaign features her motorbike, which can also be used in combat or travel in Natlan. Her kit has been confirmed to include the following abilities: Normal Attack: Flames Weave Life; Elemental Skill: The Named Moment; Elemental Burst: Hour of Burning Skies; Passive 1: Night-Shattering Radiance; Passive 2: Night Realm's Gift; Exhaust Mode; Passive 3: Gift of Flaming Flowers; and Passive 4: "Kiongozi" Flames Weave Life. Mavuika can summon a bike to use in combat or travel, and her weapon type is Claymore. She uses Pyro vision and has a max base HP of 12552, max base attack of 359, and max base defense of 792. Mavuika, equipped with her Flamestrider, deals Nightsoul-aligned Pyro damage to enemies in mid-air and on the ground while sprinting. Her Elemental Burst can be triggered when she has gained 50% or more Fighting Spirit, consuming all of it to unleash a powerful Sunfell Slice that damages opponents and enters the "Crucible of Death and Life" state. In this state, Mavuika's interruption resistance is increased, and her attacks deal more damage based on the amount of Fighting Spirit used. The Crucible of Death and Life state ends when she leaves the field. Mavuika also has several other abilities, including Night-Shattering Radiance, which restores 20 Phlogiston to the party when Nightsoul Burst is triggered, but not in certain domains. Additionally, Gift of Flaming Flowers increases Mavuika's attack power by 35% for 10 seconds when a nearby character triggers Night Soul Burst. Mavuika can switch to using her motorcycle and Phlogiston when her Nightsoul points are depleted, allowing her to maintain it while in areas with Phlogiston Mechanics. Her elemental burst does not consume energy but instead relies on Battle Will, which can be used when the Battle Will reaches 50%. Scorching Brilliance is triggered once every 10 seconds while its effect can be activated every second, and max duration increase is up to 6 seconds. When in Nightsoul's Blessing state, the activation percentage increases by 75% without counting down when off-field.
