The restaurant is located at 501 N Gilbert St, Danville, IL 61832 and is open daily from 10AM-9PM. The menu includes various chicken options such as Famous Recipe, Spicy Crispy Plus, and Breast Strips. Prices range from \$5.99 for a smaller meal to \$43.99 for larger portions. Sides like potatoes & gravy, coleslaw, and biscuits are also available, with prices starting at \$2.49 for individual servings. Other options include Creamy Cole Slaw, Chicken & Noodles, Baked Beans, Mashed Potatoes, Green Beans or Corn, Pepsi, Diet Pepsi, Dr. Pepper, Mountain Dew, Mug Root Beer, Sierra Mist, Pink Lemonade, and a delicious fried apple pie. Lee's Famous Recipe Chicken is an American quick service restaurant chain founded in 1966 by Lee Cummings. The company specializes in chicken dishes, homestyle sides, and biscuits. After selling the rights to KFC in 1964, Cummings developed his own secret recipe, known as "Famous Recipe." In 1966, he opened the first location of Harold's Take-Home in Lima, Ohio, where he introduced his Famous Recipe Chicken. The company expanded rapidly, with locations opening in several cities across the Midwest. In 1981, Cummings sold Lee's to Shoney's Restaurants, and later it was acquired by RTM Restaurant Group in 1995. However, in 2003, Lee's Famous Recipes Inc. purchased the chain back from RTM. The company changed hands again in 2013 when Famous Recipe Group LLC took over. In 2021, Artemis Lane Partners acquired the brand through their entity LFR Chicken. Today, Lee's Famous Recipe Chicken operates over 131 locations worldwide, with its headquarters based in Fort Walton Beach, Florida. The company has a global presence but primarily serves the Midwest region. Ryan Weaver serves as the CEO of Lee's, which is owned by Artemis Restaurant Corp and Ryan Weaver himself. Jocko's Root Beer Stand was established in 1949 on Georgetown Road, and it quickly became a popular spot for root beer and sandwiches. In 1956, Jocko added a Putt-Putt Golf Course and operated the location until 1961 when construction began on Interstate 74. The drive-in gave way to the east-bound ramp onto the new highway. Jocko & Shirley then bought an old New York Central Freighthouse building on Gilbert & Williams and razed it in 1965 to make way for a new venture, which turned out to be Famous Recipe Fried Chicken. In 1967, Famous Recipe Chicken opened its first store in Danville. In 1972, Jocko opened Pizza Inn next door to the existing Famous Recipe location. The company also celebrated the opening of its 100th store. Shoney's later purchased the rights to the company.
