## Dmf buff guide

Darkmoon Faire is a highly anticipated event in World of Warcraft, offering a diverse range of games, collectible rewards, and beneficial buffs. The event takes place on the first Sunday of each month, providing players with a week to accumulate Darkmoon Prize Tickets and other incentives. In addition to the various rare mounts and pets available during Darkmoon Faire, players can acquire helpful buffs by conversing with NPCs, particularly Sayge. Sayge offers seemingly random buffs, but knowing what to choose can influence which buff is received. To maximize the benefits of Sayge's buffs, players must answer his questions correctly when speaking to him about their fortune. The correct responses are outlined in a table below. Here are the available buffs from Sayge's Dark Fortune: - **Dark Fortune of Agility**: Increases agility by 10 percent - **Dark Fortune of Armor**: Increases armor by 10 percent - **Dark Fortune of Damage**: Increases all damage by six percent - **Dark Fortune of Intelligence**: Increases intellect by 10 percent - **Dark Fortune of Resistance**: Increases magical resistances by 25 percent - **Dark Fortune of Stamina**: Increases stamina by 10 percent - **Dark Fortune of Strength**: Increases strength by 10 percent - **Dark Fortune of Versatility**: Increases spirit by 10 percent Additionally, players can acquire a 10 percent reputation and experience buff called WHEEL from Darkmoon Faire. This buff provides the same benefits as the carousel but is now available on the rollercoaster, allowing players to choose their preferred ride. Furthermore, the Darkmoon Top Hat item offers an extra 10 percent boost to experience and reputation gains when collected via Darkmoon Game Prizes. VersatilityTwoOneSayge's Dark Fortune of Intelligence can be acquired by visiting Sayge at his tent in Darkmoon Faire, which lasts for two hours. To access the buff, use a Ride Ticket to ride the rollercoaster or carousel; you don't need to finish the entire ride to get the buff. Sayge's tent is located near the end of Darkmoon Faire's main path and can be accessed by speaking to a Darkmoon Faire Mystic Mage in a major city or heading to Mulgore/Helvenrest as an Alliance/Horde player. Each turn on the ride consumes a Ride Ticket, which have no expiration date. The Darkmoon Faire is a recurring event in WoW Classic, taking place every month and lasting exactly one week. It sets up on the first Friday of every month and becomes available at the start of the next Monday. The Faire rotates between two locations: Mulgore (38,39 coordinates) and Elwynn Forest (42,70 coordinates). When the Faire arrives, barkers will announce its arrival in Orgrimmar and Ironforge. Visitors can participate in Darkmoon Fortune Buffs by answering Sayge's questions. The buffs provide various benefits, such as damage increases or resistance boosts, and last for two hours with a four-hour cooldown until they can be refreshed. To access these buffs, players must have space in their inventory for the fortune quest item. In addition to the buffs, players can obtain Darkmoon Faire Prize Tickets by completing repeatable profession item turn-in quests. These tickets can be used to buy out multiple prizes, with the most coveted items being the Orb of the Darkmoon and the Amulet of the Darkmoon. Acquire Darkmoon Faire tickets by completing quests like Kit from Leatherworking (5x Rugged Leather at Chronos) or Thorium Widget (6x Thorium Widget, requiring 3x Thorium Bar and 1x Runecloth each, at Rining). Other quests award lower ticket amounts, making them more time-consuming and expensive compared to the rewards. Additionally, you can earn tickets through Orb of the Darkmoon and Amulet of the Darkmoon. The full list of available items includes cosmetic gear, with the Darkmoon Prizes deserving special mention. The Darkmoon Cards, which are now dropping worldwide, require assembling a deck by collecting 8 different cards (Elementals, Portals, Warlords, and Beasts) from humanoid or undead enemies above level 45. The Ace card can be obtained from specific enemies depending on the deck you're building. The trinkets available in the Darkmoon Faire have fun, niche effects that are not particularly exciting.
