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The Toronto Blue Jays have released their 2025 spring training schedule, which includes 30 games against 11 teams. The team will begin their season at home on February 22 with a matchup against the New York Yankees, followed by an AL East competition series against the Boston Red Sox on February 23. The Blue Jays will also play five games against the Philadelphia Phillies and see the Atlanta Braves and Detroit Tigers twice each during spring training.Baseball clubs will play a minimum of 18 games in most cases. However, teams based on Florida's west coast are required to play at least 15 or 16 games due to some exceptions. Major League Baseball (MLB) and the players' union have come to an agreement on a new collective bargaining agreement that would put an end to the ongoing 99-day lockout after ratification, paving the way for a full 162-game season. The upcoming season is expected to begin on April 7th, which is seven days past the initially planned start date of March 31st. Spring training will kick off on Sunday. This year's spring training in Arizona and Florida has been disrupted by the pandemic, as it was also affected during two previous pre-seasons. Players typically have around 42 days for pitchers and catchers to prepare, but they will only get about 28 days this time.The contests are set to kick off at two possible times, either 10:05 in the morning or 3:05 in the afternoon. The match-up on March 7th versus the Yankees is specifically slated for a slightly later 3:35 p.m. commencement.

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
