Kim kardashian sex leaked

Given article text here Kim Kardashian reveals the real reason behind making a sex tape with ex-boyfriend Ray J. The 40-year-old reality TV star shared her side of the story in an interview with the Los Angeles Times. According to Kim, she made the adult entertainment material because she was feeling "horny". This revelation comes as the reality show "Keeping Up With The Kardashians" is set to air its final episode on June 10. Cependant, Ray J a récemment affirmé que Kim et sa mère Kris Jenner étaient derrière la fuite de la vidéo et ont partagé des messages privés entre lui et Kim pour étayer ses dires. La vidéo est souvent considérée comme le déclencheur de la carrière de Kim, mais certaines personnes pensent que Kim et Kris l'ont fait fuiter pour promouvoir leur émission de télé-réalité. Ray J a déclaré qu'il n'a jamais possédé de copie de la vidéo et n'a jamais rien fait fuiter, ajoutant qu'il avait suggéré à Kim de rendre la vidéo publique après avoir vu le succès de la vidéo intime de Paris Hilton. Il prétend que Kim et lui ont signé un contrat avec Vivid Entertainment pour distribuer trois vidéos, mais que les choses n'ont pas été présentées de manière exacte dans l'émission "The Kardashians". Kim a évoqué l'émotion ressentie lorsqu'elle a récupéré les vidéos restantes grâce à son ex-mari Kanye West, mais Ray J affirme qu'il n'a jamais eu ces vidéos et que tout cela faisait partie d'un partenariat avec les Kardashian. Il estime avoir été dans l'ombre pendant plus de 14 ans, laissant les Kardashian utiliser son nom pour gagner des milliards de dollars en parlant de ce sujet sans qu'il ne puisse s'exprimer. Two sex tapes were allegedly created by Kim Kardashian and Ray J: one at the Esperanza Hotel in Cabo San Lucas, Mexico, and another in Santa Barbara. Only one of these tapes was ever released, recorded when Kim celebrated her 21st birthday in Cabo. According to Ray J, all other tapes were stored by Kim in a shoe box under her bed. He claims he never possessed any of the tapes during their relationship. The release of the tape allegedly ruined Ray J's career opportunities and relationships, even making him feel suicidal. He now wants to reveal the truth to protect his daughter from thinking he exploits women. He also accuses Kris Jenner of being involved in the sex tape plot. Kanye West flew to Los Angeles to obtain the complete sex tape from Ray J, allowing Kim to put an end to the drama before her Saturday Night Live debut. This moment was particularly sweet given the impending divorce drama between Kimye. However, this account may not be entirely accurate. In a May 4 interview with Daily Mail, Ray J claimed that he wasn't responsible for releasing the sex tape, casting doubt on the entire narrative. "I've never leaked anything. I have never leaked a sex tape in my life," he said. According to him, Kim and her mom Kris Jenner were actually behind the release of the tape. Ray J alleged that he initially pitched the idea to Kim, who then discussed it with her mom, allowing the situation to unfold beyond his control. The truth remains unclear, as Elite Daily didn't receive a response from Kim or Kris regarding this claim in time for publication. The drama surrounding Kim's sex tape began on February 28, 2007, when Vivid Entertainment released the tape. Prior to its release, Kim denied selling the tape. "There is no tape being shopped," she told TMZ in January 2007. "Ray J and I remain friends, and there is nothing he would do to spite me." However, a month later, Kim sued Vivid Entertainment, stating that the tape was released without her permission or consent. The couple had dated from 2003 to 2006. Kim's lawsuit didn't prevail, as Vivid Entertainment maintained that they had the legal right to distribute the tape. The company reportedly offered Kim and Ray J a \$1 million advance, with the duo receiving 49% of the profits from the tape sales, amounting to approximately \$49 million. Regarding Kris' involvement, TMZ sources stated that she didn't make any deals with Vivid Entertainment, although her behind-the-scenes influence couldn't be ruled out. The drama surrounding Kim's sex tape was featured in the pilot episode of Keeping Up With The Kardashians, which premiered in October 2007. J released a music video featuring a Kim lookalike, denying it was about his ex. In an interview with Hot 97 in 2013, he claimed it was "a song, not about that, it's a concept." Sure... Later, The Sun published a report stating Ray J spread rumors about Kim while in London, sharing details about her sex life and spending habits. Kim responded on Twitter, calling him out for low self-esteem or being a pathological liar. During her SNL monologue, Kim joked about her sex tape's release, implying she didn't know about it – but her mom did. The topic resurfaced in The Kardashians premiere episode, with Kim vowing to take control of the situation. Kanye later retrieved the sex tape hard drive from Ray J. In an interview with Daily Mail, Ray J denied the controversy, sharing alleged DMs between him and Kim. He claimed he, Kris, and Kim agreed on releasing the sex tape, and the Kardashians had always had access to the footage. According to reports, Kris was not involved in negotiations with Vivid Entertainment, despite claims made about her being the key player in a deal involving Kim and Ray J.
