Balraj Madhok, a stalwart of the RSS and Jan Sangh, left an indelible mark on Indian politics. A seasoned leader and writer, he penned his autobiography in three volumes, which made some astonishing revelations about the inner workings of the RSS. These included allegations of womanising, conspiracies, and immorality within the organisation's higher echelons. Notably, Madhok disclosed that top leaders of the RSS were involved in Deendayal Upadhyaya's murder as he was becoming an obstacle to their immoral activities.
