To test your newly-created Code or if youve encountered one, all you have to do is open the camera app on your smartphone and hold it over the Code. A notification should pop up prompting you to connect to the wireless network. If this didnt work, check your settings and make sure that the QR Code scanning feature is enabled. Still not working? Then all you have to do is download a third-party QR Code scanner from your smartphones app store. When friends and family come and visit, its difficult to walk each person through the settings of your WiFi. First, you have to tell them to select your network from a list, say the password out loud, and make sure that theyre connected in a single try (which, for some reason, rarely happens). With a WiFi QR Code, you can simply show the Code and have them scan it to connect to the network. You can update its content, change/add links, and fix typos, even after print. You can also track the number of scans, including where and when. Your QR Code may not be detected by a scanner because its blurry or there isnt enough contrast between the Code and the background. If youre using an Apple iPhone, simply open the camera app and hold it over a Code until a notification pops up. If youre using an Android smartphone, you may use the same method. If it didnt work, go to your settings and check if the QR Code scanning feature is enabled. If you are printing on small to medium-sized merchandise (ex: business cards or flyers), your Codes should be at least 2 x 2 cm (around 0.8 x 0.8 in). Before smartphones existed, QR Codes were read with scanners for inventory management. Nowadays, the process is much more advanced because of smartphones. If your Android phone uses Android 6.0 Marshmallow, there is a feature called Now on Tap that directly reads QR Codes. You can follow these steps to use Now on Tap to read QR Codes: Install the Google App and open it. Opt in to enable now. Navigate to Settings and select Screen search. Enable the topmost toggle (Asks Google to show you info related to whats on your home screen when you hold the Home button or search by voice). Hold down the Home button from your Android smartphone to start Now on Tap so that you can scan QR with your camera. If you prefer not to use Now on Tap, you can also install a third-party QR Code scanning app (see our app recommendations below). These versions of Android (except Android 6.0) cant scan QR Codes without a third-party app. Please see the below section for some of our app recommendations. If your smartphone uses Android version 8.0 or higher, its a good bet that it can scan QR Codes with an app. Here are three options you can use to do so: Google Screen Search To scan a QR Code with Google Screen Search, you dont need an app. You can use the following steps to scan a QR Code: Point your camera at the QR Code. Hold down the Home button and swipe up to reveal the options at the bottom. Select Whats on my screen? The short URL connected to the QR Codes information will then appear. Google Lens in the Assistant This is a super-easy way to scan QR Codes without an app. To use Google Lens in the Assistant to scan a QR Code, here are the steps: Hold down the Home button to bring up the Assistant. Depending on your version of Assistant, the Lens button may automatically appear. If not, click on the row of dots at the bottom, and then the Lens button will appear on the left-hand side.
