Netherite and its Armor Trims Offer Aesthetic Appeal: Getting netherite armor can be achieved by duplicating its material, Netherite. Piglin Bastions often contain a full set but with only a 10% chance to find other upgrades in the general bastion structure. For example, Netherite Upgrades are found within piglin bastions, note that netherite duplication is required. The easiest armor to get is sentry, thanks to how many pillager outpost chests appear and have a 25% chance of containing trim pairs. Vex trims are hard to find due to the structure in which they're located but do offer a generous 50% spawn chance within loot chests. Wild trims can be found in jungle temples where there is an increased chance of finding them, with mossy cobblestone being used for duplication purposes. Other trim options include coast, dune, wayfinder and raiser, all of which have different chances to spawn. Host Armor Trim is the fourth and final armor trim duplicated with MobFlow armor trim can be obtained by defeating the breeze mob and opening an ominous vault. The drop rate is 22.5%. Bolt Armor Trim Drops from Trial Chambers.Bolt armor trim can be found in regular Minecraft vaults, with a higher cost to duplicate compared to other trims.Smithing Templates Used for Netherite UpgradeNetherite upgrade smithing templates are used to apply decorative trims to armor using specific minerals. These templates are consumed when used and can be duplicated using diamonds and the required material.The trim doesn't have to be killed by player for it to drop and can also be duplicated with prismarine. Chest loot items vary by structure and game edition. In Java Edition, chests in Woodland Mansions have a 50% chance of containing Vex Armor Trim, while those in Jungle Temples have a 33.3% chance. Shipwrecks have a 16.7% chance of containing two map or supply chests.Smithing templates are used at smithing tables to upgrade diamond gear into netherite gear. They require a netherite upgrade, a piece of diamond gear, and a netherite ingot. The armor material and trimming material must be the same for the color palette to apply for the armor trim is darker. Armor trim smithing templates can customize an armor's appearance by using a smithing template, an armor piece and an ingot or crystal such as emerald, redstone dust, lapis lazuli, amethyst shard, nether quartz, netherite ingot, diamond, gold ingot, iron ingot, or copper ingot. There are different types of armors that can be customized including dyed leather armor and regular armor. The total possible armor combinations without enchantments exclude player wearing armor is 7.18x10³ and armor pieces with 3.67910⁹ possibilities. Any trimmed armor can again be trimmed by applying another template, replacing the old trim pattern. Trims are purely decorative for gameplay or durability of armors they apply to (with no mods used). Some trims can't be picked up by piglins like gold-trimmed armor unless made of gold and netherite-trimmed armors still can burn from fire. The trim patterns for various armors, such as Sentry, Vex, and Wild, can be applied using the smithing template. In Bedrock Edition, the Smithing Template has unique identifiers like Numeric ID, Item and Translation key. Players can upgrade their gear with Netherite Upgrades, which also have a specific identifier. The trim patterns for armors like Coast, Dune, Wayfinder, Raiser, Shaper, Host, Ward, Silence, Tide, Stout, Rib, Eye, Spire, and Bolt are all available. Achievements can be earned by using the Smithing Templates with style, such as applying at least one of the templates to an armor. The "Smithing with Style" achievement requires players to apply specific trim patterns, including Spire, Snout, Rib, Ward, Silence, Vex, Tide, and Wayfinder. The Crafting a New Look advancement involves crafting trimmed armor at a Smithing Table. Players can also use smithing templates to trim leather armor made from different materials like gold, iron, diamond, or netherite. Recent updates in the Java Edition, including 1.20 (Experimental), have added new features and increased the chances of finding certain smithing templates in chest loot. Specifically, the Netherite upgrade chance has been increased from 1.2% to 10%, "Chance to find increased from 11.1% to 16.7% for Dune, Eye, and Spire." Other items' chance to find increase in certain chests: Rib, 4.7% to 6.7%; Sentry, 20% to 25%; Stout, 4.7% to 8.3%; Vex, 4.7% to 50%; Ward, 4.7% to 5%; Wild, 20% to 33%. There are also two eyes on the head part of the armor trims that resemble those of an enderman. The longest item ID names for armor trims belong to netherite upgrade smithing template (53 characters) and sentry armor trim smithing template (35 characters). Polished blackstone pressure plates and cracked polished blackstone bricks have 34 characters. The silence armor trim is the rarest due to being found in ancient cities with a 1.7% chance to appear per chest. When lapis lazuli is used as trim material, it's referred to as "Lapis." Some armor trims make armor darker when material is same as trim. Armor Trims Now AvailableSome notable changes and additions have been made to Minecraft's armor trims in the latest updates. One significant change is that Tide, Spire, and Dune Armor Trims can now be crafted with more blocks than before, similar to how it works in Java Edition. Additionally, combining armor trims will no longer delete the old trim, as previously mentioned. Sofia Dankle from Minecraft.net explained that some of these new trims are inspired by the places where players find the templates. For instance, bastions contain a piglin-inspired trim. This adds an extra layer of excitement and exploration to the game, as players can discover unique armor trims in different environments. The "Silence" armor trim is now particularly challenging to obtain, with only a 1% chance per chest to spawn in Ancient Cities. Players who are willing to take on this challenge will be rewarded with a rare and coveted trim. These updates have undoubtedly added more depth and excitement to the world of Minecraft, allowing players to express themselves through unique armor trims and explore new possibilities in the game.

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
