Seats are reclinable and can turn 180 degrees, so families or groups of four can face each other. There are 72 seats in each GoldLeaf car, with two on each side of the aisle, so a total of four seats in each row. The lower-level dining room can seat 36 people at a time, so meals are served in two sessions. A spiral staircase connects the two levels and there is a lift for those guests with mobility concerns. Your seat is pre-assigned and listed on your boarding pass, which is given to you by Rocky Mountaineer when you check in. You will have the same seat for all days you are on the Rocky Mountaineer train. The GoldLeaf culinary experience is perfect for foodies. The Gold Leaf service is all about the luxurious train cars, featuring bi-level seating with glass-dome windows offering breathtaking views of towering mountain scenery. Seats are arranged in a 2 x 2 configuration with ample legroom and a center aisle for easy access. Each seat comes equipped with a control panel allowing you to recline and adjust the footrest. Even long-legged passengers will appreciate the spacious floor area in front of their seats. If needed, you can also activate a seat heater for added comfort! Another highlight of Gold Leaf is the exceptional dining experience. A chef and dining staff will prepare your meals and serve you during the ride, offering two delicious meals: breakfast and lunch. Meals are served in rotations, with half the car enjoying each meal at a time. While waiting for their turn, second-seating guests receive a delightful snack service at their seats. My personal favorite was the freshly baked cinnamon scones with homemade jam served as a morning snack! The pre-lunch snack consisted of dried fruit and cheese.
