The Quarterly Review Rates per square metre vary by region and project type in Kenya, with average costs ranging from Kshs 41,600 to Kshs 100,800 per square metre this year. These rates translate to Kshs 3,865 to Kshs 9,365 per square foot. The cost of building a standard bungalow in Nairobi and Mt. Kenya is Kshs 41,600, while the Coast region costs Kshs 43,250, which is a 19.31% increase over last year. In Western Kenya and Nyanza, the cost is Kshs 42,000, with a 13.98% rise compared to 2022. Kshs 5,077 per square foot. The luxurious apartment block costs Kshs 63,000 per square metre, equivalent to Kshs 5,853 per square foot. Office blocks come in three categories: standard low-rise (Kshs 58,000/sq m or Kshs 5,388/sq ft), standard high-rise (Kshs 80,150/sq m or Kshs 7,446/sq ft), and luxurious high-rise (Kshs 95,000/sq m or Kshs 8,826/sq ft). Business parks, small-scale shopping centres, urban shopping complexes, all-inclusive malls, double storey factories, high tech factories/labs, warehouses, cold storage centres, administration offices also have different prices per square metre.
