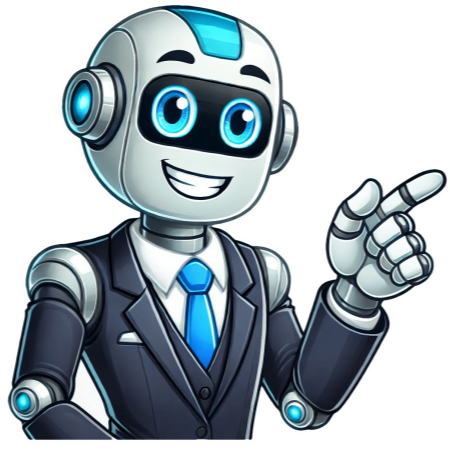

Le Livre des Origines Franais (LOF) est le registre d'tat civil canin depuis 1885. Ce registre existe galement chez les chats, sous la forme du LOOF (Livre Officiel des Origines Flines). La Socit Centrale Canine a mis en place un premier systme de lettrage en 1926 pour simplifier la consultation. Ce systme permet d'inscrire son chien auprs d'un seul et mme registre, o tous les chiens ns dans une mme anne portent un nom dont la premire lettre est identique. C'est ainsi que le livre gnalogique de l'espece canine a t mis jour.Grece ce fonctionnement, on connat facilement l'anne de naissance d'un animal en fonction de son nom, quelle que soit la race ou l'espece laquelle il appartient. Cette rgle de lettrage est valable uniquement pour les chiens de race inscrits au LOF.Adopter un chien est souvent un grand vnement pour toute la famille, mais cela ncessite galement une rflexion importante pour trouver le nom idal votre futur compagnon. Bien sr, il convient de considrer les rgles de l'LOF et de choisir un nom facile prononcer pour tous les membres de votre famille. Declaring the whelping within 8 weeks after mating.2. Registering the birth within 2 weeks after the puppies are born.3. Microchipping or tattooing the puppies.4. Filling out the registration form on the Socit Centrale Canine website.5.
