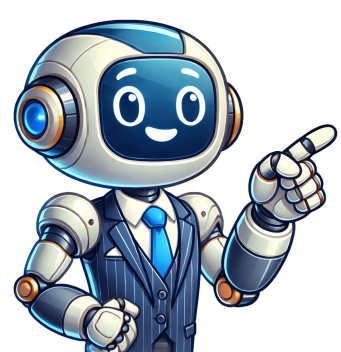


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Doa scarlet buying guide

It's still fun, especially when timing spikes, despite some issues with collision detection and animation quality. The visuals are crisp but lack environmental details, such as sand deforming under foot. The in-game store offers over 600 'swimsuits' for purchase, with premium items available through the eShop or owner shop. Shopping takes up a significant portion of the day, allowing players to develop relationships with other girls and manage their wardrobe. The casino games are also available, providing an additional way to earn money from activities like blackjack, roulette, or poker. Games were a big hit with us, spending hours at the tables and having fun. The activities boosted the girls' satisfaction levels, even if yours might start to dwindle after a few hours. "Missions" guided us through the game, providing some structure while the owner or your girl directed you to play specific games or buy certain drinks for rewards. Your Owner Level XP kept increasing as you completed each vacation cycle. When it was over, you were graded based on the satisfaction levels of all the girls on the island. New costumes and items unlocked with each repetition, but even with the encouragement, the limited activities made your vacation feel like busywork after a while. You could take photos (saved to your Switch as captures) during the various activities, but it got dull quickly. The ladies gradually tanned over time, noticeable when you changed their costumes. It was a fun detail, but not something to get too excited about. Many costumes had "Malfunction" next to them, indicating a small failure in some way. Don't worry; it just means a strap might fall or a knot loosen, and you'll never see anything inappropriate. You could eventually unlock a fan that allowed you to cause malfunctions at will with a gust of air, but there was a lot of grinding involved. The softening and hardening ointments were also available, affecting the girls' excitement levels, shape, and jiggliness. Some liquids came in bottles shaped like the items they affected. These were missing from the PS4 version, causing controversy, but they were present on Switch. "Soft 4D" was another feature, using HD rumble in a new way (although we couldn't get it to work in normal modes). We spent over 12 hours playing and still didn't muster the enthusiasm for more repetitive gameplay just to unlock this feature. Initially, we expected a volleyball game like the original DOA spin-off, but this focused on items and attending the girls, feeling more suited for mobile devices. That's okay; there's room for all types of experiences on Switch, and once you got into the rhythm, it was enjoyable. However, the internet is full of explicit content, making this seem tame in comparison. If you're coming to this game expecting something similar, you might be disappointed. For example, a dish bought in the morning may be gone by evening. To keep these items fresh, buy them during the evening session. The Owner's Store offers various items that can't be found elsewhere. The Sundries tab features Mysterious Sound Figurine, Suntan Lotion B, and Zebra Volleyball, among other items. Xtreme Venus Vacation has a different payment system than prior games, requiring more than just Zack Coins to purchase certain items. Food options include New Year's Orange, Crimson Apple, Luxury Melon, Large Pineapple, Slice of Watermelon, Donuts, Sushi, and many others. Each food item has a specific effect on the player's XP and is ranked as either a one- or two-heart gift item. Savuri's top picks are Heart Warm Milk (her favorite), Soy Milk Pudding (also her fave with three hearts), and no other treats. Monica enjoys Maple Whipped Latte (two hearted) and Papanasi (three hearted). Kanna's go-tos include Cola (two hearted), Candy Apple (three hearted, but also Takoyaki and Cotton Candy, both three hearted as well). Nagisa likes Strawberry Shake (two hearted) and Soufflé Pancake (three hearted). For Fiona, it's Herb Tea (two hearted) and Fondant Chocolate (three hearted), while Leifang favors Chinese Tea (two hearted) and Annin Tofu (three hearted). Tamaki enjoys Carbonated Water (two hearted), Alcohol (also two hearted, but Macarons are three hearted as well). Luna's top choices are Green Smoothie (two hearted) and Roasted Sweet Potato (three hearted). Kasumi and Momiji both adore Iced Coffee (two hearted), with Strawberry Millefeuille (Kasumi's three hearted pick) and Yokan Jelly (Momiji's three hearted choice) following close behind. She also likes Harmonica, Crab, Blue Wind Chime, Pizza, and pie. She's indifferent to Pink Bag, Cloth Bag, Frilled Parasol, Pink Windmill, Purple Windmill, Crystal Peac*** Fan, Tengu Fan, House Plant, Iced Cafe au Lait, Iced Tea, Orange Juice, Coconut Juice, Chocolate, Soft-Serve Ice Cream, Donut, Red Apple, Succulent Tangerine, Juicy Peach, Large Strawberry, Big Pineapple, Fried Chicken, French Fries, Newspaper, Lyrical Poetry Book, Music Book, and Novel "The Blue Bird". She dislikes Fancy Bag, Red Wind Chime, Magnifying Glass, White Watering Can, Dart Set, and Iced Coffee. I think we can all update faster if we work together as a group.
