The event is expanding into new markets, including Las Vegas and Albuquerque, while growing in existing locations. Activated Events plans to produce 20-30 events annually, diversifying its offerings with hybrid festivals like Taco Fest and The Smoke Show. Despite industry challenges, the festival remains confident due to its ability to balance expansion with quality. Younger audiences are drawn to country music's rich history, with Brooks & Dunn's return serving as a major draw. Thacher is excited about the possibilities, stating that there are endless ideas and opportunities.VIP areas with express entry, dedicated food vendors, and flushable restrooms offer a luxurious experience. Lounge seating provides an ideal spot to watch the stage while taking in the view. The venue's west side features VIP entrance gates, while general admission is at the southwest corner. Doors open at 12pm both days, but be aware that there's no re-entry once you leave. Your wristband serves as your ticket for both event days and should be treated with care. If it gets damaged or tampered with, a replacement is available for \$50, but proof of purchase is required. It's recommended to keep your wristband on during the event and follow strict guidelines to avoid issues. Ticket vendors must use authorized tickets purchased from Boots In The Park/Ticket Sauce, as unauthorized sites won't scan at the gate.A locker service is available with a 3-in-1 charging cable provided in each locker. Storing items like jackets or shoes can be convenient during the event. Accessibility features are in place for guests with disabilities, and special requests should be made at least 14 days prior to the event.Children under 5 receive free general admission, but those over 18 need a valid government-issued ID to consume alcohol.
