Kareena Kapoor and Shahid Kapoor's leaked intimate video sparks debate about consent and media ethics For Hacking, Yadav Highlights Serious Offences - Police Probe Extends to Multiple States and Financial Gains The police investigation into hacking cases has revealed that the accused had shared explicit videos on various Telegram groups for over a year. The probe aims to determine the extent of their activities, including compromised locations. The prosecution is also seeking to uncover involvement from other individuals in the case, particularly how the accused marketed and sold the illegally obtained footage. Given the accused's residences are in different states, accessing Payal Hospital's CCTV system requires a thorough investigation. The police have discovered that the accused created approximately 20 Telegram IDs, crucial for the investigation. Determining financial gains from selling videos and tracing money trails are also key objectives. The prosecution has requested 14 days of remand for all accused, but the defence argues that they had cooperated with the investigation and their detention is unnecessary. Following both sides, Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate A.J. Makwana granted remand until March 3 for Ryan and Parit, and February 27 for Vaibhav. The case took a turn when it was discovered that the accused formatted their laptops and phones to destroy evidence. However, the police have recovered devices and are working to retrieve deleted data. This incident highlights ongoing issues with privacy, as seen in other cases where private videos were leaked online, causing public embarrassment. In today's digital age, internet celebrities are exposed to unprecedented risks, including leaked video scandals that can have devastating consequences for those involved. As AI and technology continue to dominate our lives, several South Asian influencers have faced these controversies. Some have chosen silence, while others have bravely spoken out against the incidents. DESIblitz highlights eight South Asian internet personalities who fell victim to leaked video scandals. Among them is Hareem Shah, a popular TikTok figure known for her provocative content. She was embroiled in a shocking scandal when explicit videos of hers surfaced online, allegedly leaked by her former friends Sandal Khattak and Ayesha Naz. Hareem's husband Bilal revealed that his wife had filed a complaint with the FIA a year before the videos went viral but was told to wait until the content became public. In 2024, another video emerged of an individual performing a sex act on a man, although Hareem claimed it was a campaign to malign her image. The 'Kulhad Pizza' couple from Punjab, comprising Sehaj Arora and Gurpreet Kaur, were also victims of a sextape leak in September 2023. Sehaj insisted that the video was "morphed" and alleged that YouTuber Karan Dutta spread it after demanding an extortion bid. Karmita Kaur's world was turned upside down when a viral clip circulated online, purportedly showing her naked. However, she denied being in the video, claiming it was AI-generated. Karan Dutta defended her, stating that the girl in the video didn't match Karmita's physical appearance. These incidents highlight the risks and consequences faced by internet celebrities in today's digital landscape. The incidents have left a lasting impact on the victims' lives, serving as a cautionary tale for those involved in the online world. Indian influencer Gungun Gupta was caught up in a scandal when a video allegedly showed her performing an intimate act for a male caller named Deepu Chawla, who she was supposedly in a relationship with. The clip went viral, sparking polarized reactions from the public, with some blaming the leak on the boyfriend and others questioning whether it was intentionally done. Gungun finally broke her silence during Diwali 2023, writing on Instagram that people shouldn't judge her without knowing the full story and that such incidents can destroy a person's life. In similar circumstances, Pakistani YouTuber Aliza Sehar faced a viral video scandal where she was recorded doing an intimate act with a man. The incident led to rumors of kidnapping and even suicide attempts, despite Aliza having a large following on YouTube and TikTok. Some social media users blamed Aliza for exposing herself in the first place. After her wedding in November 2023, Aliza and her husband were arrested when a video surfaced showing them with a gun, but they were later released without charge. Pakistani TikTok star Ayesha Akram has also faced a private video leak scandal in 2023. While many question the clip's authenticity, it raises concerns about virtual safety and personal boundaries. Ayesha is known for her courage and empowerment, having survived a harrowing Minar-e-Pakistan harassment incident where over 300 men sexually assaulted her. Her experience continues to raise awareness about women's safety. Meanwhile, Aroob Jatoi, the wife of Pakistani YouTuber Ducky Bhai, had her life affected by the aftermath of a private video leak in April 2024. The drama unfolded when a naked deepfake of Aroob spread like wildfire online. Ducky Bhai and his wife were at the center of the controversy, with Aroob stating that she has "already gone through this" and emphasizing that no woman should face such humiliation. The star couple also offered a hefty reward for information regarding the creator of the fake video. Aroob's husband, Usama Bhatti, was not the only internet personality to face leaked video scandals in April 2024. Pakistani TikToker Usama reportedly fell victim to a leaked video as well, with some claiming it was his first wife and others alleging it was his current partner, known as 'Silent Girl' on TikTok. The authenticity of these videos has been questioned, with Aliza Sehar sharing a screenshot and asking who needed such explicit content. Usama's response revealed that the videos were from over a year ago and had been leaked to drive a wedge between him and his partner. This incident highlights the risks faced by internet celebrities in terms of their reputation and mental health when it comes to leaked video scandals. Genuine intimacy is built on trust, respect, and privacy, but these values are often betrayed and misused. In related news, massive protests broke out at Chandigarh University after a female student leaked objectionable videos of her classmates. The protests ended after the district and university administration assured students that a fair probe would be carried out. Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann condemned the incident, stating that it was heartbreaking to see his daughters being disrespected in such a way. He ordered an investigation into the matter and assured that strict action would be taken against those found responsible. The protesters demanded justice and an apology from the police and district administration, claiming that the university authorities gave a clean chit without a forensic report. They also alleged that the accused woman had admitted to making the videos. The Punjab Police arrested a woman student for allegedly recording objectionable videos of hostel inmates, while another suspect was handed over by Himachal Police. The arrested student's mobile phone is being analyzed for forensic evidence. The police refuted claims of students attempting suicide after the incident, saying it was a rumor spread on social media. The Punjab Additional Director General of Police (ADGP) advised against sensationalizing the issue and urged everyone to rely on scientific evidence rather than presumptions and assumptions.
