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Item Frames are versatile blocks that can be used to display rare items or add decor to your Minecraft world. They can be built on any solid block, making them perfect for various uses. To craft an Item Frame, you'll need 8 Sticks and 1 Leather.To set up an Item Frame in Minecraft, navigate to the Decoration Blocks menu and select it from there. A picture of flowers will be displayed next to its name. To place the frame on a block, right-click while holding it, or use the left trigger if you're playing with a controller.The frame can be placed on any side of any solid block. If you accidentally place it incorrectly, click on it to break it and return it to your inventory. However, if you're having trouble placing the frame, try crouching by holding Shift before putting it down.To store an item in the frame, equip it and right-click on the frame. Each Item Frame can hold only one item, so make sure to equip that item first. Stand in front of the frame and right-click again to transfer the item. A small image of the item will appear inside the frame.You can rotate the stored item by 45 degrees by right-clicking on the frame after placing it. To remove an item from the frame, simply hit it. When you want to use a stored item, click on the frame to make the item pop out. If your inventory has space, the game will automatically pick up the dropped item.If you place an item back in the frame, the game will remember its original rotation direction. However, if you hit an empty frame, it will break off the surface so you can pick it up and place it elsewhere.You can also create a Glow Item Frame by combining an Item Frame with a Glow Ink Sac on a crafting table. This type of frame has a soft light that allows it to be visible in dark environments and slightly lights up a room.In Creative Mode, you can obtain an invisible Item Frame by typing "/give @s item_frame(Entity Tag:[Invisible:1b])" in the chat window after enabling cheats. However, you can still see the item you place inside the frame.Want to decorate your Minecraft world? Follow these steps! First, create a fake feast by arranging frames with flowers, coral, and other items. To build lily pads, place a frame on top of a trapdoor connected to a dirt block in the water, add a sunflower inside, and finish it off with a coral block. The block texture was later changed to use the update block texture.Legacy Console Edition added item frames, increasing the world limit and displaying a message when maximum item frames are reached. TU43CU33 brought sounds to item frames, while TU56CU47 enabled name tags on framed items with anvil-added names.In Minecraft, textures are showcased through various means, such as maps floating on item frames, similar to icons on the map itself. An item frame can be placed on the side of a slab and uses the texture of birch planks. When an item is placed in an item frame, it rotates to display its different sides. The front and back of an item frame appear identical. For players who have collected rare items, such as the Ender Dragon egg, showcasing them is essential, especially on Minecraft survival servers. This is where item frames come into play, serving as a simple yet efficient decorative block to display valuable loot. Item frames are decorative items that allow players to display in-game items or blocks, functioning like picture frames. They can be placed on the surface of other blocks and act like entities in Java edition, making them moveable and eligible for ride commands. In Bedrock edition, they are considered block entities with additional data attached. Besides crafting, item frames can be obtained through looting and trading. However, looting is a less productive option as item frames naturally spawn only in End Ships of The End dimension, where they hold and display Elytra, and breaking them yields only one item frame per ship.To craft an item frame in Minecraft, you'll need to collect specific items. Sticks are one of the easiest to obtain - simply place two wooden planks vertically to turn them into sticks. You only need four planks for this. For leather, kill cows, horses, donkeys, mules, llamas or trader llamas, as they have a chance of dropping it when killed. Alternatively, kill Mooshrooms with a fair chance of getting up to 2 leathers. If in the Nether, Hoglins can be killed for 0-1 leather. A cow farm is also an efficient way to get leather.To craft an item frame:1. Open a crafting table.2. Place leather in the middle cell of the second row.3. Fill the rest with sticks.Item frames are useful for displaying items, but may require additional lighting if displayed at night or underground. Glow item frames have built-in glowing capabilities. To make a glow item frame: kill a Glow Squid to get Glow Ink Sac, then combine it with an existing item frame on the crafting table.To display an item in Minecraft, simply equip it and right-click or use the secondary action key while aiming at a vacant block space. The item will shrink to fit into the frame. You can then rotate the item by right-clicking or using the secondary action key again. To retrieve your item, break the item frame instead. Alternatively, you can display items in other creative ways, such as creating an armor stand to showcase your collection.
