If asked, replace any current files. These files include tower setups and other game data. Start the game via Steam and enjoy the new mod. You'll see a special loading screen and version info like 6.6. Extra Tips: The key file is 'data.jet,' which stores tower details and pricing. Experiment with changing this file for more tweaks. It works on Windows and Mac. Download Bloons TD 5. The game costs \$9.99, though it's on sale sometimes. Get the mod you want. High-quality ones are from BTD5 Expansion by 5h311ah. Open Steam, right-click Bloons TD Battles, then Properties. Go to Local Files and click Browse Local Files to access the game's files. Find the Assets folder and place the mod there. This replaces existing files. Restart the game, and the mod should work. Modding Bloons TD Battles Note: iOS/Mac/Android mods are rare and many Windows mods are outdated. You've been warned. Steam (Windows) Download Bloons TD Battles. It's free, so just worry about storage space. Get the mod from places like Maycrom's Hub or JamByte's Discord.
