Alternatively, select the three dots in the upper-right corner of Chrome and click the square icon in the Zoom section. For Chrome on macOS, select the green circle in the upper-left corner to activate full-screen mode. ===== Tabs, navigation buttons, extensions dock, and Omnibox. For a reader-friendly view, enable Chrome's experimental reading mode, which removes distractions and enhances readability. On Mac, use the green circle in the top-left or Ctrl+Command+F. On Windows, press F11 or click the three-dot menu, then the square icon in Zoom. To enlarge text, hold Ctrl/Command and press + or -. This guide explains Chrome's full-screen mode for Windows and macOS. On macOS, click the green circle in the top-left to enter full-screen, and click again to exit. Other methods include View > Enter Full Screen or Ctrl+Command+F. To exit, repeat the process. On Windows, F11 is the quickest way. Through the menu, select the three-dot icon, then the square in Zoom. To return to normal view, press F11 or hover near the top to click X. Full-screen mode hides desktop distractions like bookmarks, menus, tabs, and the taskbar. Chrome fills the entire screen, but text size remains unchanged. Use Zoom settings to adjust text. In the menu, select Zoom and choose + or - for enlargement or reduction. Alternatively, use keyboard shortcuts with Ctrl/Command and +/- keys.
