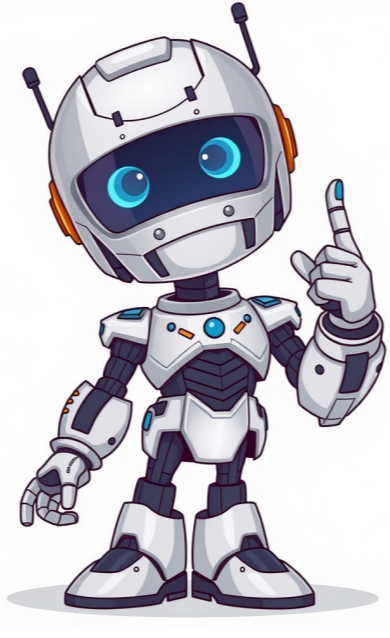

Unlike modern appliances, these stoves were built to last, with a lifespan that can easily span several decades with proper care. The environmental impact of purchasing a restored vintage O'Keefe & Merritt stove is significantly reduced, boasting a 300% to 600% decrease in resource consumption compared to manufacturing a new one. Additionally, the fact that these stoves were designed to be repaired rather than replaced speaks volumes about their durability and long-term value. In stark contrast, modern gas stoves, which are becoming increasingly popular, have limited lifespans of only 3-6 years, come with inflated prices (averaging around \$1000), and often lack essential features like built-in griddles, clocks, and the ability to reach high temperatures. The restored vintage stove, on the other hand, offers a proven track record, all the desired features, and an average lifespan of 10 times longer at a comparable price point. To undertake this restoration project, various supplies and tools are required, including acetone, aluminum solder & flux, brazing kit, and high temp epoxy adhesive. Additional materials such as brass and zinc washers, brake grease, gas line thread seal tape (yellow), and gaskets sheets can also be used. Additionally, specialized tools like a brazing torch, Dremel with abrasive buffs, grinder bits, polishing wheel, wire wheels, hammers, and needle nose pliers will be necessary.
