The Jardine Olympia Crib: A Versatile Bed for Growing Children ===== The Jardine Olympia crib is widely available at retail outlets in the United States, offering a practical and long-lasting solution for families. Designed to accommodate children from infancy to adolescence, this convertible crib can be assembled in 30 minutes and converted into a toddler bed in under 10 minutes. To assemble the crib, start by securing the front posts to the side panels using matching wood dowels. Once the front posts are temporarily attached, permanently secure them with 2 1/2-inch bolts through the top hole in the front post and the end of the side panel. For added stability, use 3-inch bolts on either side for the bottom holes. Before attaching the side panels to the headboard, ensure they are in the correct position by aligning the wood dowel with the hole in the headboard. The curve at the top of the side panels should point outward, indicating proper alignment. To install the spring assembly, place 1/2-inch bolts through the support brackets into the vertical column of holes along the front of the headboard and the back side of the front posts. Make sure all support brackets are installed at the same level to achieve the correct angle. When converting the crib to a toddler bed, move the spring assembly brackets to the lowest setting on the headboard and front posts by removing the bolts and reinserting them in the lowest holes. Additionally, install the guard rail between the front posts, securing it with one 3 1/2-inch bolt through each front post into the guard rail. For a full-size bed conversion kit, purchase separately from Jardine. The crib can be disassembled by removing eight bolts, which secure the front posts and headboard to the side panels. Finally, attach the front posts to the ends of the front panel, ensuring the top curve curves away from the bed, and secure with two 3-inch bolts.
