The apostrophe in Bluejackets has changed over time, as indicated by the various editions of The Bluejacket's Manual. The early BJM editions present a problem with their numbering, with some not stating an edition number on the cover or title page until the 1915 BJM, which boldly displays "Third Edition" on its cover. However, internal documentation and preface remarks from earlier manuals suggest that these early editions were revisions, rather than distinct versions. The United States Naval Institute holds the copyright for The Bluejacket's Manual and published it from 1902 to 1913 under their name. From 1914 to 1937, various publishers licensed to print the manual. USNI resumed as the sole publisher with the 1938 eighth edition. Reprint numbers and dates are shown where verified, but the USNI does not include all reprints in their list. Some BJMs viewed show reprint data not found in the USNI list. If an individual's BJM does not have a reprint number, they can assume it is a first edition, as these are not otherwise identified. Example of reprint data for the 19th edition has been found in the 1914 and 1927 BJMs, appearing as overprints on the title page or front fly leaf. The value of used BJMs depends on book condition and print quantity. A very good condition book with higher values for excellent items and lower value for good to fair books. The US Navy's support for the Naval Militia has been a long-standing tradition, with most maritime states and those with large lakes and rivers having their own militias. The Navy provided BJMs (Basic Issue Material) to these militias, which served as a reserve component of the Navy in earlier times and were later similar to the Coast Guard Auxiliary. The website for The Bluejacket's Manual, a publication by the US Naval Institute, aims to provide an overview of naval history and traditions. Initially used by the Coast Guard, this manual has undergone changes over the years and is now also included on this site. Other guides used by the Navy include the Recruit's Handy Book, Petty Officer's Drill Book, and Deck & Boat Book. The Bluejacket's Manual remains an essential part of the US Sailor's sea bag, serving as an introduction to the Navy for new recruits and a reference book for sailors of all ranks. The newest edition has been updated to reflect the current state of the U.S. Navy, including changes such as camouflage uniforms and new ratings. Written by retired Lieutenant Commander Thomas J. Cutler, who served in various naval roles including patrolling craft, destroyers, and aircraft carriers, this manual is primarily intended for Bluejackets but will also be welcomed by potential recruits, Navy buffs, and collectors.
