The Varrock Diary offers a set of achievements that challenge players to explore areas around Varrock, including the Barbarian Village and Edgeville. To complete these tasks, various skill, quest, and item requirements must be met, with temporary boosts allowed where necessary. Rewards can be claimed from Toby in Varrock, near the General Store. Task Requirements you will not be able to buy more discounted battlestaves from Zaff until you unlock more from completing another diary tier. even after you log out or switch worlds, this restriction remains in place. for example if all 60 hard tier battlestaves have been purchased and you finish the elite varrock diary on the same day, you won't be able to buy the remaining discounted battlestaves until dailies reset at midnight etc. note that all battlestaves will become available again when dailies reset. The remaining 60 of the 120 elite diary rewards will be available until the time dailies reset at 00:00 UTC. Once the dailies reset, the full 120 elite diary rewards will be available for purchase.

===== You will also need 50 Museum Kudos to complete this task. The Varrock armour reward is a great bonus, and you may also get a 10% chance of mining two ores at once, up to gold, with some exceptions. # Medium Reward This medium reward requires the following tasks: 1. Create a Super combat potion in Varrock West Bank. 2. Use Lunar magic to make 20 mahogany planks in the Varrock Lumber Yard (inside the fences). 3. Bake a summer pie in the Cooking Guild. 4. Smith and fletch ten rune darts within Varrock. 5. Craft 100 or more earth runes simultaneously from Essence without the use of Extracts. The rewards for this medium reward include hard elite diary rewards, including changes to the original tasks. # Hard Reward This hard reward requires a higher level of skill and will yield exclusive rewards. # Elite Reward The final task is to complete the elite reward, which includes the Varrock achievement diary reward from Zaff's barrel. A daily reward of up to 120 battlestaves from Zaff. Zaff will sell 60 discounted battlestaves for 7,000 gp each daily at the bank in the Cooking Guild. The Skull sceptre can store up to 22 charges. You can find Super attack(4), Super strength(4) and Super defence(4) with Torstol. This provides 20 nature, 40 astral and 300 earth runes for a total of 21,000 coins. To make 20 mahogany planks, mix a super combat potion in Varrock's west bank using the plank make spell. Cooking a summer pie in the Cooking Guild will give you raw materials. Smith and fletch 10 rune darts in Varrock. You can craft 100 earth runes at once or more. Every time you complete a tier of any achievement diary, you will receive some rewards. For the elite Varrock diary tier, you will get Varrock armour 4, which provides a 10% chance to mine 2 ores at once and a 10% chance to smelt 2 bars from any ore in the Edgeville furnace. The Varrock armour 4 also acts as an alternative to the prospector jacket for both exp boost and master clue steps. You need 50,000 experience in any chosen skill at level 70 or higher. Zaff will sell 120 discounted battlestaves for 7,000 gp each daily. One of the best dailies to do in the game. The Skull sceptre can store up to 26 charges.
