Blackjack is one of the fastest Thieving methods in OSRS, especially from level 45 to 91. It's intense, click-heavy, and requires focus, but the experience rates are unmatched for mid-to-high levels. Plus, it offers some gold per hour, making it a semi-profitable grind. Requirements for Blackjack Before you start knocking out bandits, you'll need to meet a few prerequisites: - Level 45 Thieving - Partial completion of The Feud quest - A blackjack (any type works) - You can buy one from Ali Morrisane. Optional: Rogue equipment - Full set doubles pickpocket loot, boosting profits. How to Blackjack Effectively Blackjacking involves luring a bandit into a private spot, knocking them out, and pickpocketing them while they're unconscious. Here's the step-by-step: - Head to Pollnivneach and find a bandit (Bearded Bandits at level 45, Pollnivnian Bandits at 55, or Menaphite Thugs at 65). - Lure the bandit to an empty house where others can't see you. - Right-click to knock out the bandit, then quickly pickpocket twice before they wake up. - If you fail the knockout, try again immediately or pickpocket to avoid combat. However, it demands attention to detail and precision clicking, requiring players to take short breaks during intense training sessions. Incorporating noted food into the inventory allows players to swiftly heal and maintain focus, eliminating the need to waste time banking or consuming multiple items.
