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I cant even get a replay no matter which machine I use. I aim for 7s and can get the first two on command every single time but I can never get the third one. All of the little slime quests end up with no req as rds over and over. I've never gotten more than a single pair in poker. I've spent over 100k gold buying more tokens and have never had more than 300 at a time. Any tips, or should I just give up on this part of the game? ===== I have been having trouble with getting replays on various machines. Despite my best efforts, I can consistently get the first two numbers but always fall short on the third. Furthermore, the little slime quests often result in no rewards due to rds being overdrawn repeatedly. In poker, I have struggled to acquire more than a single pair, and despite spending a significant amount of gold on tokens, my token count rarely exceeds 300. Any advice or guidance would be greatly appreciated at this point.Looking forward to hearing about everyone's experiences with token grabbing in DQ11 on the PS4. So far, I've been experimenting with a method that involves using slot machines to get a large number of tokens quickly. First things first, you need to buy 100 tokens from the counter person and then play a single token slot. Light up all three sections to use 3 tokens per spin, and keep spinning until you get a metal mode. Once in metal mode, you can choose to keep spinning with 3 tokens or increase it to 6 or 9 to maximize your winnings. I've found that doubling my initial metal mode rewards is a good starting point. After getting the first metal mode, exit the slot machine and repeat the process on the next one until you reach about 2-3k tokens, which should take around 30 minutes to an hour. Then, move on to the 10 token slots and follow the same pattern. I've been lucky enough to get a large number of tokens in just a couple of hours. Some people find double-or-nothing in Poker to be a quicker method for early token gains in Puerto Valor compared to Slime Quest or Slots. According to dsf856856, using Auto-Saves can be beneficial if you lose too much. It's also recommended to always use max bets and focus on getting initial hands that might create a hand. One thing I've noticed is that the Platinum Sword is generally not worth the tokens, but it does help in melee attacks with certain heroes. With enough tokens, you can acquire multiple Platinum Swords and make the early game more manageable. =====you can get big gains but it gets riskier the more rounds you go - don't always aim for like 8 rounds all the time just enough to steadily increase your stash. winning higher hands is nice and makes the gains go up exponentially in DoN but you can also lose just as easily on the first round of DoN after landing a Full House or above. so basically dont push your luck too much aim for consistency and dont get too excited when you get higher hands and lose its going to happen. i find it way more frustrating to lose at round 7+ in DoN than to lose in the first few rounds on a high hand. also you dont need to go crazy on Token gains until later in the game when you have access to Roulette, you can use Roulette to make big wins quickly and even max out your Tokens in the span of a few hours if you are lucky. with early Casino stuff having enough to get what you want and then keeping a decent amount left over to work with later is a good goal. there is nothing in the early Casinos worth trying to obtain millions of Tokens for. for poker just win & if you win over 100 tokens just accept the payout. & if you have less do double or nothing until you get 100 or more tokens. & for Double or nothing if the card is 2-4 its probably going to be higher. & if the card is A-10 it will probably be lower. & if its 5-9 its a 50-50 for each of the cards. if its a 2 or an A then you get a free win so take it. if you get a chest keep playing rounds until you get them.The art of beating dragon quest xi's casino can be overwhelming but with some strategy, you can rake in those tokens and unlock powerful gear. -----

--- To get started, make sure you have the tombola ticket which gives access to all casino games. Next, invest your tokens wisely, starting with at least 100 if possible. Looking forward to spending some time in the casino, where you can win big and gain a huge advantage in battle or snag some awesome items. When you enter, an auto save is created, so you can quickly win, leave, and come back later. Buy as many tokens as you need, but don't worry if you only have a few - you won't be using them all. Head to the poker table and bet your maximum amount. If you win, keep doubling down until you reach around 3,000 coins. If you run out of tokens, simply reload your autosave and try again. Once you've reached 3,000, exit the casino, just for a moment, to get another autosave. Then, move on to the slots. The regular slots are where the big money is made. Bet maximum and just hit the "x" button - the odds are heavily in your favor, so you'll likely win big. Stick to the 10-coin slots on the left side of the screen and avoid the 1-coin ones on the right. Later, you'll gain access to a second casino with even more lucrative options. However, be warned that this initial casino is fake until an event occurs, at which point it becomes real. For now, just hit "x" every few seconds while watching TV or browsing away from your console (if you have one). If you're lucky enough to win big, you can repeat the process with a turbo controller - or simulate it on PC using Remote Play and PS4Macro. I tried the latter method and woke up to over 1 million coins! I maxed out my 100-coin slots as well. Vullar's tips are worth sharing: if you're in the first casino, look for a poker table in the center of the room. Bet your maximum amount and double or nothing at least once when you win. Of course, save scumming is also an option - just walk out of the entrance when it loads to create another autosave. Just be sure to reload if you get unlucky. Skermac's alternative strategy involves buying 100 tokens, playing the first row in green machines, and then spanning the back row slot machines whenever you pass a green zone on the minimap. The key is to focus on slots - they offer better returns and faster wins than poker. And with PC gaming, you can even macro your way to winning big.Gaining an advantage at the casinos in Dragon Quest 11 requires a mix of luck and strategy. By understanding the games, their payouts, and how to manage your tokens effectively, you can increase your chances of winning valuable rewards. ## Casino Strategies When entering a casino, make sure to save your game before starting.
